The New Jersey Firemen's Home is a historic landmark in Boonton, New Jersey. It was established in 1898 through the generosity of the Lathrop Family and by act of the New Jersey State Legislature to care for the aged, indigent and disabled firefighters of New Jersey. It took in its first firefighters on September 22, 1900.

We are licensed and regularly inspected by the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Service to operate as a long-term care facility and residential healthcare facility.

The Home is managed by a twenty-three member Board of Managers and a New Jersey licensed Administrator / Superintendent.

Our guests receive the best of care by our licensed and certified nursing staff, certified social worker, certified activity director, certified dietary manager and licensed dietician. Our Housekeeping and Maintenance Departments ensure that our guests enjoy a safe and clean environment.

Our nursing units are staffed twenty-four hours / seven days a week; the Home's physician makes rounds five days a week and is on call twenty-four hours a day.

The New Jersey Firemen's Home is the only nursing home in the State of New Jersey dedicated exclusively to the care of all firefighters continuing our mission of dedication to New Jersey's Bravest.

The Firemen's Home is also home to our 8,000 sq. ft., two-story museum, which opened in May 1985. Steamers, ornate hose carts, and fire trucks are among the many items on display for all to see.
